Tree planting schedule Trees can be planted in both spring and fall. More plantings in Brockport are done in the spring due to the heavy DPW fall workload.

Tree Species are determined by a number of factors, such as presence of overhead utility lines, width of the tree lawn (planting space), other species of trees on the street, percentage of existing trees of a particular species within the village. The tree board is happy to work with applicants on tree species selection.

Tree planting locations are determined by factors such as driveway, gas, water, fire hydrant, street intersections, street sign and street light locations.

By applying for a tree, the applicant:

- Understands and agrees to the conditions above
- Understands that the tree is the property of the Village of Brockport and cannot be pruned without their permission
- Agrees to water the tree for two consecutive summers following planting according to instructions provided by the Tree Board (approximately 20 gallons/week)
